2021 UPROAR CABERNET SAUVIGNON

NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 Uproar is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from multiple pedigree vineyards within Napa Valley. At first impression, this wine is a deeply layered aromatic avalanche of brooding, head-spinning notes of ripe blackberry purée, cranberries, raspberry liqueur, black currants in cream, crushed rock and mocha. Subtler aromas of graphite, suede leather, sage brush, and dried orange peel add yet more dimension and complexity. The Uproar is opulent, soft, lush and pure decadence with an extreme sense of power and balance. Mouth-filling savory black and red fruits dominate and further complemented by silky tannins and a satisfyingly lengthy finish. This hedonistic wine is delicious now and over the next 15+ years.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2021 vintage was a winemaker's dream—low yields, small, intensely flavored berries and best of all an uneventful growing season. 2021 started off with very little rain, perfect growing conditions and a harvest beginning very early with the resulting grapes packed full of flavor. The 2021 vintage will be considered as exceptional producing concentrated yet balanced wines of great longevity.
